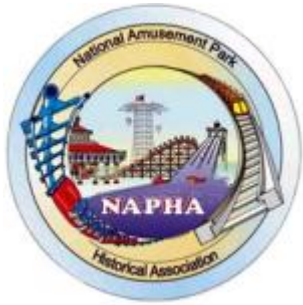

April 30, FRIDAY

The "Madness" begins!

- 2:45pm** Gather for 3:00pm entrance to **DOLLYWOOD**; late arrivals - look for a posted sign, or proceed to Guest Relations.
- 6:45 pm** Gather for a light snack and official "welcome" while the park clears (location will be noted in the registration materials that you receive when you arrive at **DOLLYWOOD**).
- 7:30 pm** Exclusive NAPHA-style ride time on Mystery Mine (patent pending, of course).
- 8:30 pm** Mystery Mine ERT ends; exit the park and make the short drive to Gatlinburg's Mysterious Mansion.
- 9:45 pm** The "**Madness**" intensifies! Special group visit to the Mysterious Mansion, including both "lights-on" and "lights-off" tours, and a special "behind-the-scenes" historical talk.

May 1, SATURDAY

The "Madness" is OUT OF CONTROL at DOLLYWOOD!

- 7:30 am** Gather for entry; **no late arrivals!** If needed, electric carts will be available for rental at member's expense.
- 8:00 am** Concurrent activities: ERT on Tornado; behind-the-scenes tour (places the public doesn't see); and a behind-the-scenes tour of Blazing Fury (including mechanical shop) with first ride of the day. Attendees choose the activity that interests them the most!
- 9:00am** Park opens to the public!
In the early afternoon, a special lunch will be served. During this time, we will celebrate Dollywood's 25th Anniversary (special presentation to the park) and conduct our traditional Heritage Fund Auction.
- 8:00pm** Gather near the entrance to Thunderhead for some wooden, "patent pending" NAPHA-style ERT!

Note: The "**Madness**" guarantees additional surprises! Special group seating at a show? Reduced rates for Skyzip? The "**Madness**" wouldn't tell! Be sure to check your registration materials for an updated schedule, and listen for announcements during the event! **WARNING!** There will be more "**Madness**".

May 2, SUNDAY

When the "**MADNESS**" subsides, NAPHA will return to santa-ty (sanity) by visiting one of America's great amusement roadside attractions- SANTA'S LAND FUN PARK & ZOO, home to the one & only, world famous **RUDICOASTER!** Regardless if the park is open to the public, NAPHA will meet in the gift shop at 10:00am. Admission and tour will follow at 10:15am. The park plans to have the **RUDICOASTER** in soaring condition for our visit! After scheduled activities at Santa's Land conclude, you are welcome to enjoy time in the park!

Dollywood is located in beautiful Pigeon Forge, Tennessee. From Interstate 40, take Exit 407 toward Sevierville/Pigeon Forge/Gatlinburg; follow TN Hwy. 66 South (which becomes US 441); at Traffic Light #8 in Pigeon Forge, turn left & follow the signs! Direction to the Mysterious Mansion in Gatlinburg, and Santa's Land in Cherokee, will be provided at the event. Be mindful that there have been rockslides on I-40 three miles past the Tennessee and North Carolina border that have closed the interstate. If you have any questions, please consult Tennessee's Department of Transportation website. Lengthy detours have been posted in the past.

Let's Get The Mountain Madness II Ball Rolling &

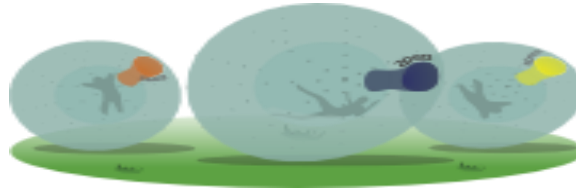


NAPHA-STYLE!

Are you getting to the mountains early? Can't wait for the madness? NAPHA has a great idea to "get the ball rolling" for Mountain Madness II. This will truly be a totally "abZORBing" optional activity! A NAPHA first! Join us April 30th at high noon (12pm).

What does it mean to ZORB?

The ZORB is an 11 foot high inflatable transparent sphere which you can ride inside. Two feet of air protects you from the ground enabling you to Zorb down mountains at high speed. ZORB riding was invented in New Zealand. No special skills are necessary. The Smokey Mountains are the only US ZORB location. There are two ways to ZORB: Zorbüt is a ride in which you are securely harnessed inside the ZORB for a wild roll down the hill; Zydro adds water inside the ZORB and you slip, slide, and spin inside the ZORB all the way down the hill (a cross between a waterslide and a roller coaster). If you take a "wet" ride, please bring a swimsuit or a change of clothing. More information at www.zorb.com



Directions:

ZORB is located within Pigeon Forge off the Parkway (Highway 441). Go to Traffic Light One, then head east to Sugar Hollow Road. There will be signs. Zorb is at 203 Sugar Hollow Road, ½ mile on the left. Their phone number is 1-865-428-2422.

NAPHA will meet at the ZORB facility on Friday, April 30th @ high noon (12pm). If you would like to reserve a spot, please submit a check (no money orders) written to NAPHA for \$10 per participant. In order to get a group discount, we will need twenty people to register for this optional activity. Your check will be returned on April 30th if you attend the optional event. If you can't make it to the ZORB facility on the day of the event, you will forfeit your check, and your fee will be considered a donation to NAPHA's Heritage Fund. The \$10 per participant fee will be used only to guarantee your participation. Once we gather at the ZORB facility, there is a combination of ride packages ranging in price based upon the number of people in the ZORB, what type of ride you wish to take, and if you want to upgrade your experience. ZORB rides are priced from \$33 and increase based on your ride preferences. All ZORB experiences will be at the expense of the participant on the day of the optional activity. If you don't wish to ride, feel free to join us! Watching is fun!

There are some inherent risks associated with ZORB. All participants are required to sign a liability waiver and consent form. There are age and weight restrictions posted, as well as a copy of the waiver, on ZORB's website.

You must agree to the following: "By participation in this optional activity, I assume all the risks and waive, release, and hold harmless the National Amusement Park Historical Association (NAPHA) and their representative officers, Directors, Executives, and other representatives from any and all liabilities related to this activity. The participant will be deemed a customer of Zorb Smokey Mountains".
